In 2007, Big Fix provided 5,915 no-cost spay and neuter surgeries to low income families. Last year, the voucher program provided more than 14,600 surgeries.

"As an animal lover," says Siner. "The best way I can help the tens of thousands of unwanted pets from being euthanized is to support a spay and neuter initiative that is as effective and impactful as the FACCs' Big Fix campaign."
